

Shire of Capel – Notice of Proposed Local Laws



In April 2017 the Shire of Capel advertised draft proposed cat and dog local laws for public comment. Changes to the draft laws resulting from submissions received during the advertising period mean that amended drafts are now being advertised for a new period of public comment.

The purpose and effect of these laws are as follows.

Purpose	Effect
<i>Shire of Capel Cats Local Law 2017</i>	
To provide Council with measures in addition to those under the <i>Cat Act 2011</i> to control the keeping of cats.	To control the number of cats that can be kept and places where cats can be kept.
<i>Shire of Capel Dogs Local Law 2017</i>	
To make provisions about the impounding of dogs, to control the number of dogs that can be kept on premises and the manner of keeping those dogs.	To extend the control over dogs which exists under the <i>Dog Act 1976</i>

The proposed Local Laws are available for inspection at the Shire of Capel Administration Building, 31 Forrest Road, Capel during normal office hours, Mon – Fri, 8.30 am – 4.30 pm.
