What is Emergency WA?

Emergency WA is a new website to provide you with the best available information and community warnings about emergencies in Western Australia.

Here you will find alerts and warnings about fires, floods, storms, earthquakes, cyclones, hazardous material incidents and more.

Emergency WA replaces the alerts pages on the Department of Fire and Emergency Services and Department of Parks and Wildlife websites.

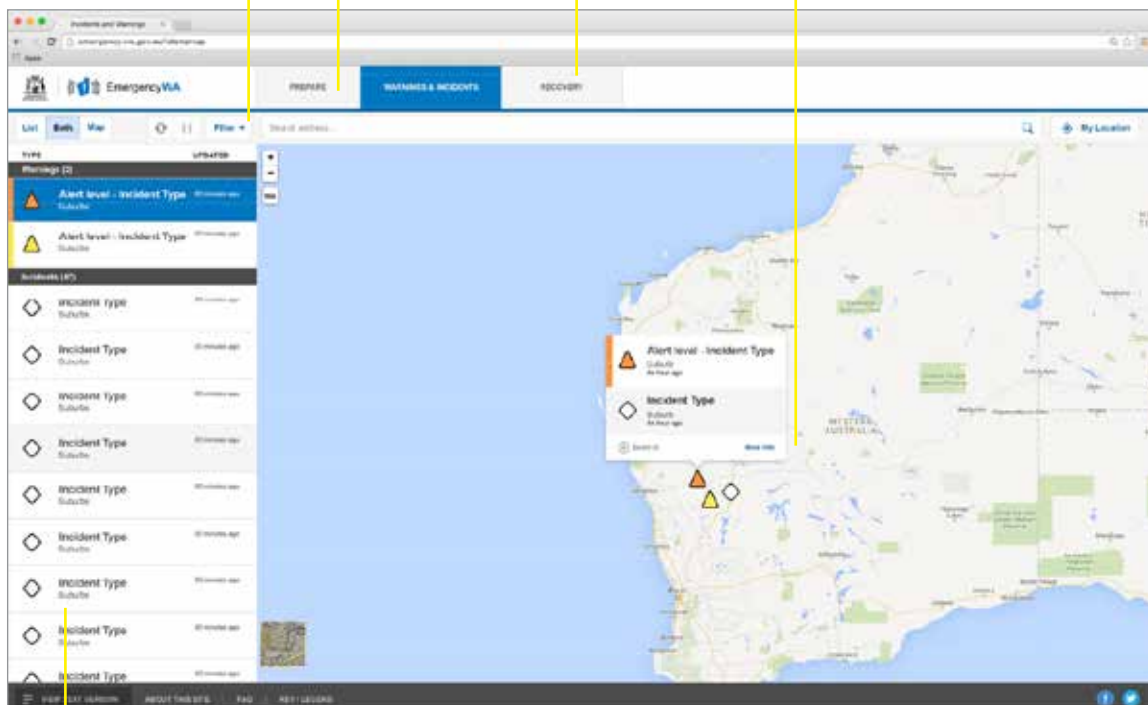
What will I find on the new website?

Access to Fire Danger Ratings and Total Fire Bans by using the 'Filter' button.

Links to information on preparing for an emergency, as well as recovery after an emergency.

A user-friendly layout with search and filter capabilities, Locate Me function and text only version for screen readers, enabling the user to find specific details about an incident.

A Google Map display showing the location of active emergency incidents and warnings across Western Australia.



A live feed of all fire, rescue and other incidents reported to the DFES Communication Centre.

Access to live feeds of the emergency information in RSS and CAP AU formats. These feeds are used by Emergency AUS, LocalEye and other apps and warning products to obtain warning information.

Information about active prescribed burns being undertaken by government agencies and private landowners.

Remember:

- Always seek information from a variety of sources during emergencies. Never rely on any one source.
- Be aware of your surroundings, stay connected with your community and take action for your safety at the first sign of fire or other emergency.
