Important Information

1. Applicants must be 18 years of age or over.
2. This application is a request for permission to consume liquor at a Council Facility only. Under no circumstances does it give the hirer authorisation to sell liquor directly or indirectly or charge an entry fee to the function.
3. A Liquor License may be needed to sell, supply or serve alcohol in compliance with the Liquor Control Act of 1988. This can be obtained from the Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor and a copy must be provided to the Shire. Visit www.rgl.wa.gov.au for more information.
4. Alcohol Consumption Applications should be submitted at the same time as your Facility Hire Application.
5. If approved, this application form will be returned to the applicant, and must be readily available for inspection at the facility on the date(s) of the scheduled booking.
6. Applications for the consumption of alcohol may be refused, and a permit may be revoked at anytime.

Declaration

I Name declare that the information above is to the best of my knowledge, true and correct. I agree to undertake that in the event of this application being approved by Council, the following conditions will be strictly adhered to:

- 1 Only invited guests or bona fide members of the applicant's group, organisation or club will consume liquor on the premises.
- 2 Liquor will not be consumed, supplied or made available to any person under the age of 18 years of age.
- 3 If it is the intention of the applicant to sell liquor to any person, or exchange for value, either directly or indirectly, a permit must first be obtained from the Bunbury Clerk of Courts.
- 4 No liquor will be consumed by or supplied to any person to whom a charge has been made, either directly or indirectly, for admission to the facility, unless a permit has been obtained from the Bunbury Clerk of Courts.
- 5 No kegs to be placed or served from in Council facilities.
- 6 Alcohol consumption is restricted to the premises hired only and is not to be consumed outside these premises. Consumption of alcohol in public open space or reserve areas is considered illegal.
- 7 Permits will only be issued to 12 midnight at the latest and not for a period of longer than 12 hours in duration.
- 8 The Hirer must comply with provision of the Liquor Licensing Act 1988.
