Tuesday 20th February, 2018

- 06.30am Pick up at Capel Community Centre

- 10.00am Depart on the Ferry to Rottnest

The cost is \$240 per person. This is subsidised by \$55 by the Shire of Capel & the Department of Local Government & Communities. The cost includes the return bus, return ferry, admission fee onto the Island, luggage transfer to your Unit, lunch on both days, accommodation in shared cabins with ocean views and the Grand Island Tour by Coach & Train.

The Grand Island Tour includes all of Rottnest's must see locations including the Wadjemup Lighthouse, Henrietta Rocks, Oliver Hill Gun Fortification & Tunnels, Picturesque Parker Point, the Fur Seal Colony and the majestic look-out point at the rugged Cathedral Rocks & Capel Vlamingh. The Tour is on an air-conditioned coach and includes a relaxing 5.5km train ride on the "Captain Hussey."

The shared cabins include: 2 x 3 bedroom Units in South Thomson Bay with Premium Views; 1 x 2 bedroom Unit in North Thomson Bay with Ocean Views; 2 x 3 bedroom Units in North Thomson Bay with Ocean Views; and 2 x 3 bedroom Units in Geordie Bay with Premium View. It would be ideal if those registering could state who they would like to share a Unit with. Alternatively, the Shire can match you up with other suitable seniors.
